Program: Adventure Myanmar

Yangon, Golden Rock, Bagan, Mandalay and Inle Lake (08 Days/07 Nights)

Day 01: Arrival Yangon (by morning/ midday flight)

Upon arrival to Yangon by morning/ midday flight, you will be welcomed by tour guides and transferred to hotel. You will be arranged on the trip planning depending upon your arrival time. If time permits, we will visit the Chaukhtatgyi where the colossal reclining Buddha Statue lies, and the Shwedagon Pagoda. We will stay overnight in Yangon.

Day 02 & 3: Excursion to Kyaikhtiyo (Golden Rock)

After the breakfast, take a bus to the camp Kimpun (about 5 hours), from where the uphill motor road to hermit's hill starts. Take the uphill pickup truck to reach the hermit's hill. A short trek (about an hour) would take you to the top of the Golden Rock Mountain. Enjoy sunset view over deep forested mountain.



We will stay overnight in Hotel.

After the breakfast, we will go around the Hermit's hill to observe the Gold Rock, a large boulder positioned well balanced on the cliff of that mountain – seems to be defying the force of gravity from the spur of the cliff. Breakfast at the hotel and descend the mountain to reach back to start our return journey back to Yangon. We will stay overnight in Yangon.

Day 04: Yangon–Bagan



After the breakfast at the hotel, we will take flight to Bagan. Bagan City, along with Angkor Wat is the most pre-eminent religious old cities in South East Asia. The sightseeing starts with a visit to **Nyaung Oo market** – a typical local market; followed by **Shwezigon Pagoda**, one believed to be the holiest to be enshrined with Buddha tooth and hair. We will visit **Gubyaukgyi Temple** which is the 13th century 'cave temple' with fine frescoes of scenes from Jatas and **Anada**

Temple, one of the masterpieces of Mon architecture remaining in Bagan. Before sunset, we will have individual biking trips as a map will be provided and you will have an opportunity to explore Bagan on your own.

Day 05: Bagan–Mandalay

Fly to Mandalay. Arrive Mandalay and sightseeing at Mandalay, the last capital of Myanmar kingdom, includes **Mahamuni Buddha Image** – believed to be cast in bronze in front of Buddha himself and nowadays gilded with thick gold leaf; **gold leaf hammering, marble carving, and tapestry making**. Afternoon sightseeing includes **Shwenandaw monastery** – still existing masterpiece of last Myanmar kingdom’s architecture in teak and wood carving; **Kuthodaw Pagoda** – renowned as the world’s largest book; and **Mandalay Hill** – regarded a natural watch tower in the plain region of Mandalay – to view the sunset.

Day 06 & 07: Mandalay to Heho and Inlae



Fly to Heho. Drive to Inle Lake exists 900 meters above the sea level and the home land of Innthar tribe. We will visit the regional once in every fifth day market takes place around the different area of the Inle Lake if today coincides with the market day. **Phaungdawoo Pagoda** is famous for its richly gilded five small Buddha images and its history. **Ngaphechaung monastery** (formerly also known as jumping cat monastery for trained jumping cats) is more than one and a half century old monastery with its collection of ancient Buddha Images. Other attractions include unique leg–rowing style and fishing method of the Innthar; floating gardens and vegetable plantations; and weaving factory and black smith.

Taking the boat to down south into a small twist and turn creek, we would reach the **Indein village**; a small village located at the south western bank of the lake famous for its ruined clusters of pagodas dated back to 16th century. You will also have the chance to chat with villagers during the sightseeing. We will take flight back to Yangon for the night.

Overnight in Yangon

Day 08: Departure Yangon

The last day in Myanmar to say goodbye to this beautiful golden country. You will be transferred from your hotel to the airport for your onward.

All people entering Myanmar requires visa which must be obtained from Embassy of Union of Myanmar. Please check with the Embassy in your country for up to date information regarding visa application process. We strongly advise you to start arranging your visa process at least 45 days prior to your departure.

We recommend travelers to have vaccinations in advance of travel. We also suggest you consult with your doctor to discuss about your health care needs specific to your holiday. You must be comprehensively insured as condition of travelling with Exquizit Travel.
